PMEL Specialist

As PMEL Specialist you support all the teams in the organisation on Planning, Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning (PMEL) related activities to ensure the impact of Agriterra's work can be monitored and demonstrated towards relevant stakeholders. In this position you report directly to the Team Leader PMEL and you support your regional PMEL Specialists colleagues to ensure the appropriate planning and controlling procedures are adopted!

Duties

- Peer support (and back stopper): to the regional PMEL specialist during all the stages of project management: acquisition, set-up, implementation and closing.
- Review & control: provide the M&E "Go/No Go" decision to acquisition proposals, and review of reports towards external donors.
- Preparation of reports: support the preparation of consolidated internal reports on the overall project portfolio of Agriterra. Identifying potential risks and abnormalities in the project portfolio and communicate them to the regional team and escalate to managerial positions when necessary
- Quality insurance: Ensure homogeneity in our work through checks, online trainings, and communicate/share experiences. Ensure consistent logical frameworks by supporting peers. Ensure quality of surveys and survey-generated data.

- Impact evaluation: develop impact evaluation methodologies for projects, seek and lead collaborations with research institutions, coach internships on impact evaluation and communicate results of impact evaluations (e.g., posts, news, presentations, conferences etc.).

What do you offer?

- Bachelor's degree in development related field, or relevant working experience at this level;
- 3 years of relevant experience in PMEL / M&E role;
- Demonstrated experience working with results frameworks and performance monitoring;
- Familiar with Excel, Word, Teams, Zoom, experience with Power BI and / or statistical software on impact evaluation is a plus;
- Fluent in English (speaking and writing) and other local language(s) where relevant;
