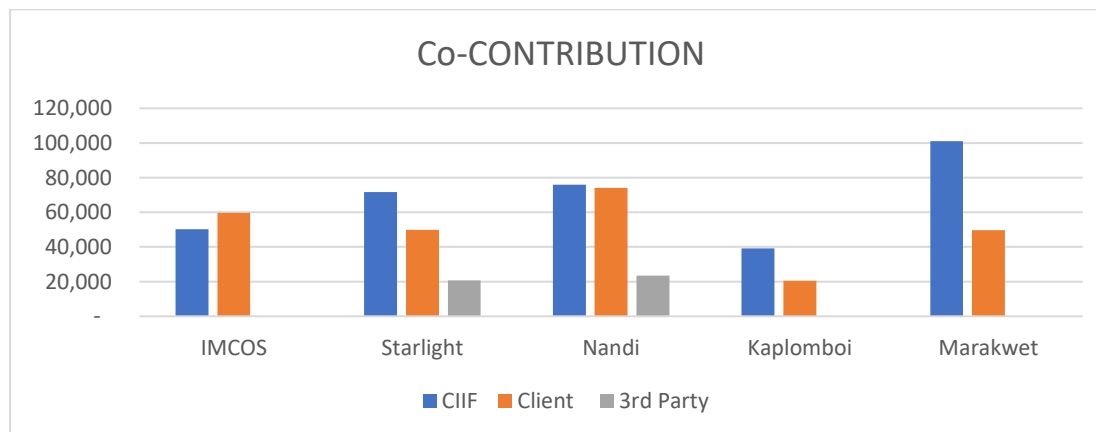

### CRAFT CO-CONTRIBUTION PER CLIENT

The total climate investments mobilized is EUR 614,124. Of the total climate investments, the cooperatives contributed 41% and mobilized an additional 7.2% from third parties through the Climate Smart Business plans developed. The remaining 51.2% was contributed by CRAFT project under the Climate Innovation Investment Fund(CIIF).
