

# **INTRODUCTION**



ICA (International Co-operative Alliance) defines a cooperative as an autonomous association of persons united voluntarily to meet their common economic, social, and cultural needs and aspirations through a jointly-owned and democratically-controlled enterprise. While this definition is simple and easy to understand, it is also one of the most misunderstood

business organisation models, especially in the modern business world where all transaction should comply to the prevailing legal regulations, including taxation. During the three-day workshop participants will gain knowledge, through a very interactive process on how the agricultural cooperative (AC) operates in Indonesia contemporary business environment.
